Lt. Governor Hank Mann will be back with us May 1 to educate and orient us as Kiwanians.


MEETING - APRIL 24 AT INDIAN HILLS MOTEL RESTAURANT - 6:30 p.m.


Dues are now payable at \$12.00 per member. Please make your check payable to Kiwanis Club of Chester.
