All clubs visited within the year. 8. Recognition of outstanding achievement by members. 9. Bulletin issued every two weeks. Deadline first and third Wednesdays. (Editor's comment: A Kiwan-o-gram every month.) 10. 60% of membership attending Special Olympics events. 11. Each member attends at least one Detention Home night - last Thursday each month. 12. Establish an "Official Greeter" at each meeting. 13. Pre-induction orientation of each new member. 14. Fall and Spring Membership Roundup: Oyster Roast, Nov. 9th at Koogler's. 15. Representation at Mid-Winters Conference, District Convention and International Convention. 16. Emphasis on retention of current members. 17. Community "Thank-you" night, honoring local businesses who have contributed to Kiwanis events over the years. 18. Club participation in community clean-up events. 19. Participation in Career Night at Dale and Bird High Schools. 20. Joint Kiwanis/Key Club community service project...other than Volksmarsch.
