nounced ... sometime in November. Thanks!

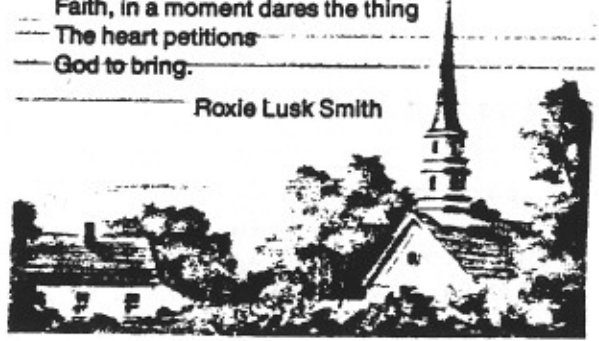
Where Faith Begins
