Young Children: Priority One--Lead Poisoning and Pediatric Trauma

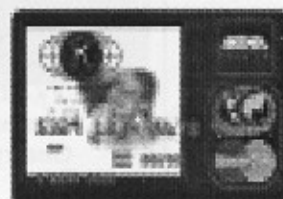
Protecting Children from Media Violence: A Kiwanis Concern
